Youth Program update (Marcy)

- First time females have signed up for youth program
- Beginning discussion on the creation of a teaching square – revisiting of a long forgotten project

Lease and Insurance Update (Dallas, Tom C)

- Lease has been signed and delivered to UTRCA
- Set back in Insurance timeline – IMBA website had coding errors which resulted in the club not properly being able to register as a club, could only register as a person
- Insurance papers have been handed in – new proof on insurance will be delivered to the club before last years insurance runs out

Club Jerseys (Chris)
